We had a rather good run delivering to homes for 100 years, but consumer habits changed, and money was saved picking up milk

with the groceries at a store.

Fast forward twenty eight years and with the pandemic shutting down our state and most of the country, our phone lines start

lighting up with people looking for home delivery. You asked and we responded.

Publicity from a Wall Street Journal article and then a CNN news report brought us national attention and 300 home delivery

customers in a short period of time. It seemed like home delivery was going to be the next big thing, however the trend started to

shift in late May as people felt safe to once again venture out into the stores to do their shopping.

We have been honored to provide this service to all of you, however the time has come to say goodbye once again to this throwback

from an earlier time. The entire Wade family was profoundly grateful to be able to serve our community during these unusual

times."

Rest assured Wade's Dairy will be around for many years to come serving schools and wholesale customers. And they are pleased to
